An exciting way to show off your drawing and painting skills for a gift that is uniquely yours.

Which paintings should you consider for this? A few helpful tips will lead you on to be bold and creative



- 1. Think about the shape of the objects you want to have printed onto, Holly the dog on the right started out as a **square** greetings card which was fine for the coaster and for the candle tin. Any size painting would work for this but the focus is Holly
- 2. You will have the choice of having your centre of interest placed onto the object **or** the whole painting. To see what a section would look like do the following:
- 3. Get a small mount frame (a piece of cardboard with a square or rectangle cut out)
- 4. Look through the mount and see a section you like, make a note

Bring along your chosen artwork together with the order form and the rest will be taken care of.
